Enclosed please find the Wage and Fringe Benefit Rate Card for the work year July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018.

**Journeyman Wage Rates – Effective August 1, 2017**

Area 1: Increase \$2.00 per hour for a total of \$46.40

Area 2: Increase \$2.00 per hour for a total of \$40.52

Area 3: Increase \$2.00 per hour for a total of \$41.02

Area 4: Increase \$2.00 per hour for a total of \$39.67

**Fringe Benefits – Effective July 1, 2017 – Entire 46 Counties Area**

Health and Welfare:	Increase of twenty-five cents (\$.25) per hour for a total of eleven dollars and forty-five cents (\$11.45) per hour
Pension:	Increase of fifteen cents (\$.15) per hour for a total of nine dollars and sixty-five cents (\$9.65) per hour
Annuity:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75) per hour
Vacation:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and forty-five cents (\$2.45) per hour
Work Fee:	Increase of six cents (\$.06) per hour for a total of one dollar and ninety-three cents (\$1.93) per hour
Training:	Increase of five cents (\$.05) per hour for a total of eighty-two cents (\$.82) per hour
Industry Promotion:	Increase of two cents (\$.02) per hour for a total of fifty-one cents (\$.51) per hour
Carpenters International Training Fund:	No increase. Remains at ten cents (\$.10) per hour
Contract Work Preservation:	No increase. Remains at five cents (\$.05) per hour
Western States Drywall/Lathing Industry Labor-Management Cooperation Committee (WSDLI):	No increase. Remains at twenty-eight cents (\$.28) per hour

**Fringe Benefits Senior Stocker/Scrapper (employed by the same contractor for 2000 hours, consecutively or cumulatively) – Effective July 1, 2017 - Entire 46 Counties Area**

Health and Welfare:	Increase of twenty-five cents (\$.25) per hour for a total of eleven dollars and forty-five cents (\$11.45) per hour
Pension:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and seventy cents (\$2.70) per hour
Annuity:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75) per hour
Vacation:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and forty-five cents (\$2.45) per hour
Work Fee:	Increase of six cents (\$.06) per hour for a total of one dollar and eighty-eight cents (\$1.88) per hour

**Wages Stocker/Scrapper – Effective August 1, 2017**



Pension:	No increase. Remains at one dollar and ten cents (\$1.10) per hour
Vacation:	No increase. Remains at two dollars and forty-five cents (\$2.45) per hour
