Enclosed please find the Wage and Fringe Benefit Rate Card for the work year of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

Wage Rates – Effective July 1, 2024

Area 1: Increase \$3.62 per hour for a total of \$64.01

Area 2: Increase \$3.62 per hour for a total of \$58.13

Area 3: Increase \$3.62 per hour for a total of \$58.63

Area 4: Increase \$3.62 per hour for a total of \$57.28

Fringe Benefits – Effective July 1, 2024 – Entire 46 Counties Area

Health and Welfare:	Increase of thirty-eight cents (\$0.38) per hour for a total of twelve dollars and eighty-seven cents (\$12.87) per hour.
Pension:	Increase of fifteen cents (\$0.15) per hour for a total of eleven dollars and forty cents (\$11.40) per hour.
Annuity:	Increase of twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per hour for a total of three dollars and sixty-six cents (\$3.66) per hour.
Vacation:	Increase of nineteen cents (\$0.19) per hour for a total of three dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$3.37) per hour.
Work Fee:	Increase of twelve cents (\$0.12) per hour for a total of two dollars and fifty-two cents (\$2.52) per hour.
Training:	Increase of seven cents (\$0.07) per hour for a total of one dollar and twenty cents (\$1.20) per hour.
Vacation/Holiday/Sick Leave Admin.:	No increase. Remains at ten cents (\$0.10) per hour.
Industry Promotion:	Increase of four cents (\$0.04) per hour for a total of seventy cents (\$0.70) per hour.
Carpenters International Training Fund:	Increase of one cent (\$0.01) per hour for a total of fourteen cents (\$0.14) per hour.
Contract Work Preservation:	No increase. Remains at five cents (\$0.05) per hour.
Western States Drywall/Lathing Industry Labor-Management Cooperation Committee (WSDLI):	No increase. Remains at twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per hour.

Fringe Benefits Senior Stocker-Scraper (employed by the same contractor for 2000 hours consecutively or cumulatively) – Effective July 1, 2024 - Entire 46 Counties Area

Health and Welfare:	Increase of thirty-eight cents (\$0.38) per hour for a total of twelve dollars and eighty-seven cents (\$12.87) per hour.
Pension:	Increase of fifteen cents (\$0.15) per hour for a total of three dollars and sixty-three cents (\$3.63) per hour.
Annuity:	Increase of twenty-eight cents (\$0.28) per hour for a total of three dollars and sixty-six cents (\$3.66) per hour.
Vacation:	Increase of nineteen cents (\$0.19) per hour for a total of three dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$3.37) per hour.
Work Fee:	Increase of twelve cents (\$0.12) per hour for a total of two dollars and forty-seven cents (\$2.47) per hour.
Vacation/Holiday/Sick Leave Admin.:	No increase. Remains at ten cents (\$0.10) per hour.

Fringe Benefits Stocker-Scraper – Effective July 1, 2024 – Entire 46 Counties Area

Health and Welfare:	Increase of thirty-eight cents (\$0.38) per hour for a total of twelve dollars and eighty-seven cents (\$12.87) per hour.
Pension:	Increase of fifteen cents (\$0.15) per hour for a total of one dollar and ninety-five cents (\$1.95) per hour.
Vacation:	Increase of nineteen cents (\$0.19) per hour for a total of three dollars and thirty-seven cents (\$3.37) per hour.
Work Fee:	Increase of twelve cents (\$0.12) per hour for a total of two dollars and forty-seven cents (\$2.47) per hour.
Vacation/Holiday/Sick Leave Admin.:	No increase. Remains at ten cents (\$0.10) per hour.
