**Wage Rates – Effective July 1, 2023**

Area 1: Increase \$3.29 per hour for a total of \$60.39

Area 2: Increase \$3.29 per hour for a total of \$54.51

Area 3: Increase \$3.29 per hour for a total of \$55.01

Area 4: Increase \$3.29 per hour for a total of \$53.66

**Fringe Benefits – Effective July 1, 2023 – Entire 46 Counties Area**

Health and Welfare:	Increase of thirty-nine cents (\$0.39) per hour for a total of twelve dollars and forty-nine cents (\$12.49) per hour
Pension:	Increase of fifteen cents (\$0.15) per hour for a total of eleven dollars and twenty-five cents (\$11.25) per hour
Annuity:	Increase of thirty-three cents (\$0.33) per hour for a total of three dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$3.38) per hour
