SUBJECT: AB 2311 (Low) – SUPPORT – Request for Signature

Dear Governor Newsom:

The measure requires that public entities, on projects subject to any skilled and trained workforce requirement, place a notice of the requirement in all project bid documents and contracts. If enacted, the bill will ensure that all parties to a construction contract are aware of the requirement to utilize a skilled and trained workforce.

Some public agencies have failed to inform contractors, who in turn cannot inform subcontractors, that projects are subject to the to the skilled and trained requirement until after work has already commenced. Those occurrences have resulted in significant confusion and difficulty in complying with the requirement. Proper notice will assist contractors and subcontractors in their preparation for and compliance with the skilled and trained workforce policy.

For the aforementioned reasons, I support AB 2311 and request your signature on this important measure.
