State Minimum Wage Increases January 1st December 7, 2017

Please remember that in 2016 California passed legislation to increase the State minimum wage to \$15 per hour over time. Under the provisions of that law, California's minimum wage will increase on January 1, 2018 to \$11 per hour for employers with 26 employees or more and \$10.50 for employers with 25 or fewer employees.

Below is the mandated schedule to get the State minimum wage to \$15 by 2023.

| Date | Minimum Wage for Employers with 25 Employees or Less | Minimum Wage for Employers with 26 Employees or More |

| January 1, 2018 | \$10.50/hour | \$11.00/hour |
| January 1, 2019 | \$11.00/hour | \$12.00/hour |
| January 1, 2020 | \$12.00/hour | \$13.00/hour |
| January 1, 2021 | \$13.00/hour | \$14.00/hour |
| January 1, 2022 | \$14.00/hour | \$15.00/hour |
| January 1, 2023 | \$15.00/hour | |
